The instructor above has 3 FTE years as of Fall 2016. However, Spring 2015 was her/his 3<sup>rd</sup> semester at 25%, so she/he is not yet eligible despite having 3 FTE years (since you can only have 2 semesters at 25%).

Now if this instructor's count begins in Spring 2011, and if he/she is 50% or more in Spring 2017, then he/she will only have had 2 semesters (Fall 2014, Spring 2015) at 25% (i.e. not counting Fall 2010 which would have been a 3<sup>rd</sup> semester at 25%). Therefore, this instructor will meet the criteria for continuing appointment (she/he has a minimum of 3 FTE years with no more than 2 semesters at 25%) in Spring 2017.
